
Relaxation Lounge Goals:

General criteria for FF & E Selection

Function:
Although furniture is primarily chosen to serve a general purpose, pieces can also serve one or more specific functions. For example, seating units or chairs provide comfort, but some are meant specific in their use, such as a highbacked chair or a lounge chair for relaxing.

Comfort, Ease of Use, and Ergonomics:
Good furniture design allows users accommodate the human body. Comfort levels can vary for each person because of differences in size and proportion, as well as degree of psychological satisfaction. The physical fit, or interface, between the human body and furniture enables to carry out a particular task more easily and comfortably, reducing fatigue and reducing the risk of injury. Furniture pieces featuring different parts of the body. Furniture components may also be used by several different users, since pieces are rarely tailored for only one person's use.
Ergonomics are related to the user-friendliness aspects of furniture pieces. For example, the contours for a reclining armchair will be designed specifically. Ease can also refer to the convenience factor in moving furniture for cleaning or repositioning. Heavy, bulky pieces should be on gliders or casters for ease of movement.

Ergonomic considerations:
Human beings vary in shape, size, and age, producing a wide range of anthropometric dimensions. Human-made objects, furniture, and other pieces of our built environment are designed to accommodate an "average" size, based on statistical studies of populations.

Psychological considerations:
People will only differ physically, but they also have distinct emotional and psychological profiles. Furniture selection and placement can complement or distract from these feelings and needs.

As the traffic in the library is more and of versatile type the material should be easier for maintenance requiring or very durable.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION
